Claudia Black will address the challenging family legacy of addiction: how generational repetition occurs with the addictive family system, issues of both physical and emotional abandonment that fuel addiction, generational repetition and other self defeating behaviors.

Recovery for family members can occur whether or not the addict recovers, and it can occur long past living with active addiction. Claudia will focus on foundational issues of setting the stage for ongoing recovery.

Unhealthy shame is often the foundational issue from which family members need to recover. Claudia will discuss a variety of shame screens, offering insights into shifting from self defeating response to greater health. She will offer practical clinical guidelines in working with family members, garnering a picture of what their recovery could entail.



Claudia Black is a renowned author and trainer internationally recognized for her pioneering and contemporary work with family systems and addictive disorders. She is the clinical architect and actively involved in the Claudia Black Young Adult Center at The Meadows. Claudia Black's seminal work with children impacted by substance abuse in the late 1970s created the foundation for the adult child movement.
